Re: Coronavirus/COVID-19

To help mitigate the spread of COVID-19, the Chichester Town Library will close to the public and reduce its services beginning Tuesday, March 17, 2020. This reduction in services will continue until further notice, and will include use of the community meeting room and the Down Under used book store. This decision has not been easy and has been made out of the utmost concern for the health, safety and well-being of library patrons, staff, volunteers and the community. We are following guidelines of both the Center for Disease Control (CDC) and the New Hampshire Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) and will continue to do so throughout this public health event.

Library materials that are due may be returned through the book drop.

Patrons of the Chichester Town Library may continue to access and download audio books, eBooks and magazines from the New Hampshire State Library either through the Chichester Town Library portion of the Town website or at https://nh.overdrive.com/ or by using the Libby app. There is no charge for this service. In order to check out materials, you will need to select the Chichester Town Library from the drop-down menu and enter your library card number. If you have questions or do not know your library card number, please send us an email or leave a message on the Library voicemail and we will get back to you as soon as possible.

The Library website has an online catalogue of available books. In addition, library staff will be available during our business hours to respond to questions or to see if other requests can be filled, such as for books, magazines, audio books and DVDs.

Delivery will take place in the Library parking lot at an agreed upon time.
